Eligibility Criteria at Admission

Applies only to the first semester, based on the Korean track
The English track has different eligibility criteria

- TOPIK Level 6: 90% tuition waiver
- TOPIK Level 5 or Completion Certificate of Level 6 from the University Language Institute: 70% tuition waiver
- TOPIK Level 4 or Completion Certificate of Level 5 from the University Language Institute: 60% tuition waiver
- TOPIK Level 3 or Completion Certificate of Level 4 from the University Language Institute: 40% tuition waiver
- No TOPIK Certification: 30% tuition waiver
- No TOPIK Certification (Arts and Physical Education Majors): 20% tuition waiver
